The Church in God's Eternal Purpose

- Ephesians 3:21
- to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

- The church was in the eternal purpose of God.
 - <u>Before the</u> <u>foundation of the world</u>

God laid out the plans and specifications by which and of which his church would be built.

(Ephesians 1:4)

He <u>predestined</u> the church!

• Ephesians 1:5 He predestined us to be adopted as his sons through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will

 That is God predetermined that man would be saved through Jesus Christ.

When God created man, he knew the probability of mankind's fall

• God also knew His own righteous nature.

• God knew that He, as a righteous and just God, could not allow ONE

single un-forgiven sin to go unpunished. • God is a social God.

• Out of His own infinite nature of love and mercy He desired to have

children of His own.
(Romans 8:16)

However, His children must be Holy for God is Holy.
 (1st Peter 1:15)

•Revelation 3:7 These are the words of him who is holy and true

 True holiness is contingent upon responsibility coupled with the freedom of choice.

- So it was that within these divine principles that God created mankind.
 - God created mortal man thus creating the necessity of a plan of redemption.

The <u>church</u>
was the <u>solution</u>
<u>to God's dilemma.</u>

• This is a dilemma from man's viewpoint not from God's viewpoint.

• In Romans Paul wrote of the "foreordination" or "

predestination" of God.

- Having made mankind
 of flesh & blood God knew of the
 possibility of sin.
 - Remember that
 TRUE HOLINESS

 is based upon
 RESPONSIBILITY

 coupled with
 FREEDOM OF CHOICE.

 In anticipation of mankind's fall from TRUE HOLINESS God purposed or <u>predetermined</u> or predestined that salvation from such a fall would be available through His church. 16

- 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14
- from the beginning God chose you to be saved through the sanctifying work of the Spirit and through belief in the truth.

- 2 Thessalonians 2:14
- He called you to this through our gospel, that you might share in the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ.

 God decreed that salvation was only possible through **FAITH** in and **OBEDIENCE** to the GOSPEL.

• God made mankind free moral agents.

• Therefore, mankind must through his own free will accept the gospel of Jesus Christ.

• Thus God ONLY justifies those who believe and <u>obey</u> the Gospel.

 to him <u>be glory</u> in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.

• Ephesians 3:21

• Ephesians 3:21 speaks of 5 things:

• # 1 The Being to be praised.

• # 2 The <u>praise</u> to be offered.

• # 3 The <u>sphere</u> where the offering is to be made.

• # 4 The medium of the praise.

• # 5 The <u>duration</u> of the praise.

•The being to be praised is God.

- to him be glory
- Ephesians 3:21

• The praise, and glory is for the GRACE of GOD through Jesus Christ.

• The sphere for the offering of such praise and glory is the church.

•The medium for the giving of praise and glory is Jesus Christ.

 The duration of the praise, and the glory is be "unto all generations for ever and ever. Amen"

 That is why the the Revelation letter pictures the worship of our Lord as being day and night:

> Revelation 4:8 and they rest not day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty,

ALL SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS

• Ephesians 1:3 Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in the heavenly realms with every spiritual blessing in Christ.

• NO HOPE

• Ephesians 2:12 without Christ, without hope, without God in the world.

 To have hope one must be in in Christ and in the church. (Ephesians 2:12; Acts 2:47)

 No glory can be given to God through a man-made church or through a fraternal order or through a social club.

- Ephesians 3:14-15
- For this reason I kneel before the Father, 15 from whom his whole family in heaven and on earth derives its name.

Paul prays for the spiritual enrichment of the Ephesian saints.

• Ephesians 3:16

 I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being,

 Every individual has two beings: the outward and the inward.

• The Holy Spirit through the medium of the word makes His appeal to the inward being.

•Ephesians 3:17

- •Christ dwells
- in your hearts
- •through faith.

Romans 10:17

So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

- Ephesians 3:17
 that you,
 being rooted
 and grounded in love,
- Like a flower that is tenderly planted and well maintained in love.

• That being <u>rooted</u> & <u>grounded</u> that they might <u>grow</u>.

- Ephesians 3:18
- May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height

To meditate upon those things which one does not see by the eye or hear by the ear.

 One must **contemplate** the great work of God through the church, his instrument of salvation.

•Ephesians 3:19

and to know this love that surpasses knowledge

•Ephesians 3:19

•That you may be filled to the measure of all the fulness of God.

•The purpose of the church is a changed life.

• What if, instead of memorizing and analyzing the teachings of Jesus, we just obeyed those teachings?

 What if we actually took the commands of Jesus seriously?

What if we focused on being
 what we have
 been called to be

• instead of just <u>knowing</u>

what we have been called to be?

• The church is the ultimate plan.

• The church is the ultimate institution.

• The church is the ultimate organization.

• The church is the ultimate source of salvation.

• The church is the ultimate answer to man's dilemma. (not God's dilemma!)
